The 2014-15 year saw an increase in the number of transfer degree applications from 37 in 2013-14 to close to 400 in 2014-15, without a corresponding increase in staffing. This also came with an increase in the applicable number of transfer degree associated transcript evaluations. These are time sensitive documents that must be processed by a set deadline. To meet these challenges, evaluators had to be repurposed from normally assigned work. This resulted in a subsequent slowdown in an already overtaxed evaluations process. Despite this adversity transfer application were processed on time, and other time dependent tasks such as IGETC were done in a timely fashion for students.

Evaluations implemented degree audits templates for new transfer degrees in administration of justice, early childhood education, history, and political science to bring the Degree Works system in line with new offerings and helped facilitate better information for counselors and students regarding SSSP ADT's. In concert with counseling it also helped

monitor ED plan development and provide technical assistance, to meet SSSP priority registration mandates.
