Resident and Non-Resident Enrollment

- Total resident and non-resident FTES decreased 7% from 1,688 to 1,569.
- Resident FTES is down 7% from 1,439 to 1,340, and non-resident FTES is down 8% from 249 to 229.

Resident and Non-Resident Enrollment Categories

- Within the resident category, total enrollment of AB540 students decreased 23% from 698 to 536 while FTES decreased 18% from 66 to 54.
- Within the non-resident category, enrollment of students from another country (with or without an educational visa) decreased 12% from 1,766 to 1,558 while FTES decreased 12% from 183 to 161.

International Students

- International students with F1 or FZ visa status headcount is at 833, down from 890 last summer, a -6% decrease.
- Females comprise 44% of the international students with F1 or FZ visa status.
- Top countries of origin for F1 or FZ international students includes: China, Japan, Taiwan, Indonesia, South Korea, and Vietnam.

Ethnicity

- Latino/a headcount decreased 13% from 2,275 to 1,988 and FTES decreased 13% from 338 to 293.
- African American headcount decreased 2% from 421 to 412 and FTES remained flat at 69.
- Filipino headcount decreased 9% from 618 to 561 while FTES decreased 11% from 93 to 83.

Student Type

- First-time student headcount increased 5% from 1,221 to 1,283 and FTES increased 8% from 160 to 172.
- Special admit high school student headcount increased 319% from 22 to 88 while FTES increased 400% from 2 to 10. This student group has seen consistent but small growth each quarter for the past 2 years.
- First-time transfer student headcount decreased 15% from 1,861 to 1,579 while FTES decreased 16% from 263 to 220.
- Our largest group in the summer, continuing students, headcount decreased 7% from 6,466 to 5,998 and FTES decreased 8% from 1,058 to 978.

Zip Code Groupings

- Headcount from Cupertino, Sunnyvale, Los Altos, Mountain View, Palo Alto, Los Gatos and Saratoga increased 1% from 2,708 to 2,722. This area has grown over the last few terms.
- Headcount from San Jose East of 880, Alviso, Milpitas, Fremont, Union City, Newark, Hayward and East Palo Alto decreased 13% from 5,177 to 4,519.
- Headcount from San Jose Other, Santa Clara, Morgan Hill, Gilroy, and Campbell decreased 10% from 2,438 to 2,195.
- Headcount from Santa Cruz County has increased 14% from 81 to 92 while headcount from Alameda County increased 22% from 73 to 89.

Zip Code Groupings – Percentage of Total Enrolled

- As a percentage of total headcount, students from Cupertino, Sunnyvale, Los Altos, Mountain View, Palo Alto, Los Gatos and Saratoga increased 2% at 27% of total headcount enrollment.
- Headcount from San Jose East of 880, Alviso, Milpitas, Fremont, Union City, Newark, Hayward and East Palo Alto decreased 3% at 44% of total headcount.
- Headcount from San Jose Other, Santa Clara, Morgan Hill, Gilroy, and Campbell decreased 1% at 21 of total enrollment.
- Santa Cruz County and Alameda County represent 1% of total headcount.
