Requirements for Flint Center community benefit initiative process to be considered inclusive of student needs:

1. A published and distributed calendar of engagement opportunities for multiple groups of students in various forms over the course of the next year.
2. Clear, quantifiable ways in which student needs will be factored in to the decision-making processes, including projected needs. Weighing mechanisms for the final decision must be clearly communicated— i.e., to what extent is final decision made based on investor return, etc.
3. Meaningful inclusion of multiple students in all meetings where decisions are made. Students must have the necessary information to contribute in ways the chancellor considers meaningful, including financials and investor information.
4. Communication in advance of engagement opportunities, with informational materials disseminated to students through faculty, DASB, and the Communications Office.

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
