**Proposed for 2022-2023:**

Proficiency in mathematics which may be met by completing MATH 109 or 114 or 130 or equivalent or higher with a grade of C or better (or) achieving an AP (Calculus AB, Calculus BC, Calculus BC/AB subscore, or Statistics) exam score of 3 or higher (or) an IB Mathematics HL exam score of 4 or higher (or) a CLEP (College Algebra, College Algebra - Trigonometry, Pre-calculus or Calculus) exam score of 50 or higher.
